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Vedic Heritage Teaching Program for Children

The Vedic Heritage Teaching Program is a guide for educational institutions, communities and families that wish to teach Vedic Heritage to their children in an authentic, systematic manner. The subject matter has been organized into twelve parts, tailored to the ages of the children.

Growing up in the modern society implies exposure to global culture and having access to the world of Information Technology. Indian children living in the West as well as living in India need to study their heritage in an instructive and deliberate way, if they are to imbibe it in their own lives. It offers an insight into the vision of the Vedas, the vast literature and religious culture of India. This program is offered as a 23 book series, a first of its kind in imparting cultural and knowledge traditions of India.

- ✦ Parts One to Five of the books address children of ages six to ten years and offers teaching materials for a five - year program that cover Panchatantra, Puranic Tales, Rāmāyaṇa, v and Mahābhārata.
- ✦ Parts Six to Nine address children of ages eleven to fourteen years and offers teaching materials for a four-year program that cover topics including Values, Íśvara and Religious Disciplines, Religious culture and Vedic Knowledge. It also has plays which may be enacted by the students.
- ✦ Parts Ten to Twelve address teenagers between the age of fifteen and seventeen years and offers teaching materials for a three-year program that cover topics like human development and spiritual growth, contemporary teen issues, Vedic Knowledge including Vedāṅgas, Upāṅgas and Upavedas and an Introduction to the Bhagavad Gita concluding the 12 year study program.

In addition to the programs being institutionalized, these programs are offered as live zoom sessions or community programs at local temples or preferred venue.

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Story behind the books

Writing the 23 book Vedic Heritage series of books has been a pilgrimage into the spiritual heritage of India, enriching my life in more ways than I can ever express. The pilgrimage that began as an inquiry into the meaning of our heritage ended with the discovery of its immense wealth and beauty, a discovery that heralds a new beginning in Self-Awakening.

The evolution of the Purna Vidya books seem to parallel my own life and growth. When I look back on how my life has unfolded, I find that many people, events and experiences in my life around the globe have deeply influenced me. A constant note in this symphony of life experiences has been my love for learning the Scriptures with my guru, Pujya Sri Swami Dayananda Saraswati and serving his Institution for over 25 years.

I began teaching Vedānta and Heritage classes in New York & New Jersey in 1982 and established Arsha Dharma Kulam in New York to facilitate my work. The 23 book Vedic Heritage series is the product of a decade of teaching experience, providing adults an opportunity to discover the meaning of our Cultural forms, while providing a format for teaching children. Personally speaking, living and writing on the banks of the sacred Ganges, was a great inspiration for me. In the Indian culture, the Ganges is looked upon not simply as a river, but as the symbol of the perennial flow of knowledge. She became the blessing of my life in the form of Purna Vidya, revealing the mysteries of the Universe.

That the first words of the teaching programs were written in the United States - the frontier land of discovery and adventure – and the last words were written in India – the repository of wisdom and home of the Vedic Heritage – appears to be more than a mere coincidence. It seems to point to the universality of what is contained in the heritage and drive home the fact that Truth transcends geographic, cultural, religious and racial bounds. It is symbolic of what the book attempts to do which is to bring an understanding of the ancient Vedic Heritage into the lives of adults and children of Indian origin all over the world.

Unlike fifty years ago, today Indians are immigrating to the West in increasing numbers, searching for economic freedom and life opportunities. In crossing the ocean and establishing new roots far away from their home, Indians find a natural break down of cultural forms and traditions in their new communities. As one encounters a totally different culture and lifestyle, there is a painful search to reclaim one's Indian identity. Some Indians reject and criticise everything Western and idealise everything Indian. Some have built temples and community centres and have tried to recreate the India they left behind. Others have compensated for their alienation by denying their Indian identity and adopting a Western way of life. In doing so, Indians isolate themselves from other Indian immigrants and thus deny their heritage.

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Only when we understand our heritage as adults will we be equipped to teach it to our children. To accomplish this, one must necessarily appreciate one's new environment and discover the relevance of one's cultural upbringing in light of the new society. The West has been the home for the first generation of Indian children and has shaped their cultural identity. Their Indian heritage is linked merely to their parents and grandparents. To appreciate and imbibe their Vedic Heritage without the infrastructure of the Indian society, it is critical that they understand the relevance of the heritage in their own lives. Understanding one's cultural and religious traditions during one's developmental years is essential to intimately identifying with one's heritage. By writing these books, I hope that many individual parents and the Indian community outside India will rediscover the profound wisdom that pervades their culture. I also hope that for cross-cultural communities, this work will open the doors to the discovery of a profound living culture and its spiritual tradition.
